Eligible high school students have the option to go above and beyond their enrolled curriculum and take on an additional course (or two) online with our Edgenuity program. This program is equipped with instructors that provide video lessons and written coursework for students to work through at their own pace. The self-paced learning and pretesting allow students to spend more time on what they need and less time on what they've already mastered. Once a student has mastered assignments and tests, the credit is added to their transcript.

Currently, we have been able to recover 30 semesters of coursework for students that have taken the initiative to get this done. We are so proud of the students that are taking advantage of this opportunity to move forward on their journey to greatness!
